

Top 10 Spots of Dongguk

1. Noble Eightfold Path

The heart of Dongguk University, the eightfold path symbolizing the eightfold truths demonstrates the founding spirit of Dongguk. It is an open space for contemplation.

2. Central Library

A state-of-the-art library housing over 1.35 million books.

3. Mt. Namsan trail

A trail connecting the beautiful mountain of Namsan to the Dongguk campus. A true beauty of Dongguk.

4. Lee Hae-Rang Theater

A theater named after the late Lee Hae-Rang who made history in Korean drama in the $20^{\rm th}$ century. The theater is becoming a new center of art.

5. Jeonggakwon

The 20th tangible cultural property of Seoul Metropolitan City. This temple provides opportunity for first-hand experience of Buddhist spirit.

6. University Museum

A Buddhist museum established in 1963. It houses over 3,100 relics including 2 national treasures and 9 valuable historic items.

7. Manhae Monument

A symbolic monument built in a tribute to Manhae Han Yong-Un who was among the first graduates of Dongguk. Nice looking, comfortable benches provides you with a pleasant space to meet your friends.

8. Outdoor Café

A place to enjoy a happy cup of coffee in the fresh air.

9. Hanul Maru (Rooftop Garden)

Beautiful gardens on the rooftop of each building on the campus. In particular, the Hanul Maru on top of the Central Library gives you a fantastic view of Namsan and Seoul's city center.

10. Dongguk Hall of Honor

A hall installed to briefly introduce the donors of Dongguk. The hall is located on the third floor of the main building, the most visited spot on campus, so that as many Dongguk people as possible become aware of the donors.
